

PSALMODY

Antiphon: He shall cover you with his pinions, **you shall not be afraid of any terror by night.**

Psalm 91

1 He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High,*
abides under the shadow of the Almighty.

2 He shall say to the Lord,

**"You are my refuge and my stronghold,*
my God in whom I put my trust."**

3 He shall deliver you from the snare of the hunter*
and from the deadly pestilence.

**4 He shall cover you with his pinions,
and you shall find refuge under his wings;*
his faithfulness shall be a shield and buckler.**

5 You shall not be afraid of any terror by night,*
nor of the arrow that flies by day:

**6 Of the plague that stalks in the darkness,*
